

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 17 Oct 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain affecting the far southeast will quickly clear to give most places a a dry, bright day with some spells of sunshine. A few generally light showers are expected, these mainly across northern and western Scotland, Northern Ireland and northwest England. Feeling fresher for many. Most places staying dry overnight with clear periods and a fairly widespread ground frost.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
High pressure will become established on Thursday and Friday ensuring largely dry, settled weather with bright or sunny spells. It should feel pleasant enough in the sunshine by day, but will be chilly overnight with a frost likely in places.
