

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 24 Apr 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and locally heavy rain will move eastward this morning, clearing all but northern Scotland during the day. Showers will follow from the west, sometimes heavy with isolated thunder and hail particularly in the east, mostly clearing away during the evening. Today will be a cooler, though still mild, day.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Some showers will occur in western parts initially on Friday, otherwise it will be fine until rain spreads into northern Britain during the day, becoming heavy at times in the northwest. It will be warm with rain periods continuing mainly in the west on Saturday, locally heavy in the northwest.
