

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 04 Jul 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered heavy showers across Scotland, although the Northern Isles will have rain. Generally bright with isolated showers elsewhere, until rain spreads across southwest England and south Wales this afternoon. Overnight bands of rain will move northeastwards, although much of Scotland will become dry as the showers die away. Becoming windy with localised gales across southwest England and south Wales.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Generally wet and windy across southwest England and south Wales, with gales along exposed coasts. Northern Scotland, and later eastern England, mostly dry. Otherwise showers or longer spells of rain, and rather cool, for both Saturday and Sunday.
