Headline:

Wintry showers in north extending southwards. Becoming colder and windier.

Today:

Cloudy Wales, southern/central England. Showers east and north-facing hills/coasts England and Scotland. Band of showers through S.Scotland and N.Ireland moving slowly south. Snow inland/on hills. Winds increasing in north.

Tonight:

Sleet/snow showers in areas exposed to the north. Otherwise, mostly dry with a frost.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Persistent sleet/snow crossing Scotland, reaching N.Ireland. Sleet/snow showers E.England and far southwest. Feeling very cold. Quite windy.
