Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will spread northwards today, heavy across southern England this morning. It may fall as snow as it reaches northern parts of the UK, perhaps even to low levels for a time. Brighter, showery weather will follow and it will be much less windy. Showers will largely die out overnight but clearer skies will give patchy frost, ice and fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
It will be a bright start in eastern Britain on Sunday but wet and windy weather will soon spread from the southwest, affecting all areas by evening with gales around coasts. It will stay windy on Monday with scattered showers.
