Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a cold, frosty and locally icy start in the west, however many will have a fine day here with sunny spells. Across central and eastern areas it will be mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain and some hill snow. It will also continue to be breezy, particularly over the Northern Isles.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday and Friday will be cold and cloudy for many with further wintry showers in the east. The best of the sunshine will be across the west, however it will turn breezier here. This breeze will become more widespread on Friday making it feel bitterly cold.
