Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland will have rain at first, then showers, and rain will affect other western areas too, although fragmenting this morning. It will be warm and mostly sunny over parts of east Wales and England, but some heavy, thundery showers will then develop later in central and western areas, spreading northeastwards during the night.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Many places will have a mix of sunny spells and heavy showers on Saturday, some of which are likely to be thundery. Still very warm in the southeast, but becoming cooler and fresher everywhere during Sunday. Generally breezy, particularly in the west.
