

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 13 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland remaining dry with spells of sunshine. Elsewhere, light showery rain in parts of southern England will extend northwards to affect most of England and Wales. The showers could be locally heavy with a risk of thunder overnight across southern UK. Strong easterly winds will affect most parts, although winds lighter in the south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Scotland mostly dry with spells of sunshine. Otherwise the unsettled spell continuing across the rest of Britain. There will be further rain or showers, occasionally heavy with a risk of thunder. Strong easterly winds will affect many eastern parts, where it will feel cool.
