Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cold start with a hard frost, but after a fine start in the east, cloud will increase everywhere. Sleet and snow already over N.Ireland, will spread to northern England and southern Scotland through the day, with rain or sleet spreading across more southern parts. Still chilly but perhaps a little less cold briefly in the south.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
The cold spell continues. Sunshine and wintry showers on Monday but there is a risk later in the day, overnight and at first on Tuesday of some more persistent rain, sleet and snow affecting southern areas, perhaps giving some accumulations of snow again.
