

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 03 May 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered light showers over Northern Scotland and Eastern England at first. The rest of the UK starts dry, bright and cold. Cloud will thicken over all but West Wales and Cornwall. By afternoon Scotland will become dry while heavier showers affect central England. Overnight rain will spread southwards over Scotland. Elsewhere, clear and frosty.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will continue over Northern Scotland through Tuesday. A further rain band will affect Northern Ireland overnight and then move northeast to affect Northern Scotland through Wednesday. Elsewhere, cloudy and dry, just a few light showers, mainly over Northern England. Fresh winds, becoming light or moderate.
