Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Tuesday 07 July to 1200 UTC Wednesday 08 July 2015

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure bringing unsettled and windy weather will move slowly eastwards across the United Kingdom during today and away into Scandinavia during Wednesday. High pressure will then build from the southwest on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly, backing northwesterly later, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Occasional rain, fog patches until later, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing mainly 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, then becoming northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasional rain rough later in east.

Showers, occasionally thundery, rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in east.

Showers, mainly fair later.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest, then northwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, occasionally thundery, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain then showers, fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest, then northwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Rain or showers, fair later.

Mainly good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, veering northwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, mainly fair later.

Mainly good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers at first, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, veering northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Showers at first.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing mainly 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming mainly slight later.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 or 7, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time.

Squally showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasional rain moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming mainly slight later.
Fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering northwest later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in south.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering west or northwest later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, veering west or northwest, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Occasional rain or showers, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later, then backing west later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in southeast, veering northwesterly 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Showers at first.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in North Channel.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth later.
Showers at first.
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest becoming cyclonic, 3 or 4, then becoming northwest 5 to 7 later.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Rain or showers, fog patches until later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then backing southwest later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.
Showers at first.
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly backing northerly, 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.
Occasional rain, showers later, fog patches until later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6, backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.
Showers.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly backing northerly, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain, showers later, fog patches until later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6, backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low over Scotland will track east over the North Sea with associated frontal trough moving over Shetland Waters. A strong northerly flow follows Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.
Moderate, becoming mainly rough.
Rain or drizzle.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 08 Jul until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 08 Jul:

Northeast backing north 6 or 7.

Rough, becoming very rough in east.

Rain at first, showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 to 5 increasing 5 to 6 by mid-afternoon, perhaps 7 mid-channel overnight.

Moderate to rather rough increasing rather rough to rough overnight.

Isolated showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 6, veering northwest 4 to 5 by early evening, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, becoming variable 1 to 3 by midday.

Rather rough, locally rough at first, decreasing becoming moderate during the evening and slight Thursday morning, with a low swell.

Isolated showers at first.

Good.

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
