Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Generally cloudy, although some sunny intervals will occur, the best of these likely across southern and eastern areas. Patchy light rain and drizzle will continue to affect parts of north Wales, northwest England, N.Ireland and especially western Scotland, while largely dying out elsewhere. Becoming breezy in the north. Mild.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday: Rain initially across N.Ireland, north and western Scotland will gradually transfer southeast through the day, although central and southeast England will stay largely dry. Generally mild.

Saturday: Rain will continue southeastwards, clearing southeast England Saturday night. Noticeably cooler weather, with broken cloud and wintry showers, will follow from the northwest.
