Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Patchy rain in south clearing but lingering into afternoon across parts of southwest England. Otherwise it should be dry. Misty start in parts of south, some coastal mist in southwest. Sunny intervals should develop, the best of these in the north. Temperatures mainly near normal, chillier eastern coasts. Cloud continuing to break, allowing clear spells to develop tonight. Touch of ground frost Scotland and northern England, perhaps isolated slight air frost in rural parts.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday and Wednesday most parts dry with good sunny periods, but cloud and drizzle west Scotland and Northern Ireland. Fairly warm generally but chillier windward coasts.
