Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Patchy rain in the south soon clearing, then sunny intervals with some southwestern areas remaining dry. However, wintry showers will spread from the north, some heavy, bringing some snowfall to northern hills especially. Tonight, clear spells and further wintry showers with longer spells of sleet or snow for some central and southern areas. It will be frosty for many.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Remaining cold with clear or sunny spells and wintry showers. Some showers will be heavy and prolonged with hail and thunder with further temporary snowfall likely in places, especially, but not exclusively over hills. There will frost night and morning.
