Headline:

Rain, more persistent in south, slowly dying out. Misty overnight.

Today:

Mild. Rain across southern Wales, central and southwest England initially, soon reaching southeast England. Mainly cloudy conditions with patchy drizzle elsewhere, and also later across Wales and western England. Some cloud breaks Scotland and N.Ireland.

Tonight:

Becoming mostly dry, with a mix of mist/fog/low cloud forming.

Outlook for Friday:

Rain spreading southeast, not reaching southeast England until evening. Clearer weather following to the northwest.
