REMARKS.

Wednesday

Atmospherical pressure has decreased slowly at all our own stations since yesterday - principally in the north, but in the south of France it has increased a little. Readings are however nearly uniform, the lowest (at Aberdeeen) being only 0.31 in. below that at Rochefort.

Temperature has increased several degrees in the South-east of England; elsewhere the change is small.

The winds are very light in these Islands. They are variable in Scotland, and generally SW^{ly} in England and Ireland; whilst in the south of France they are NW^{ly}.

The sky is overcast or cloudy, with fog in the south and west. The sea is calm.

REMARKS.

Thurs. day

Barometrical pressure is again generally lower than it was yesterday, but the change has now been greatest in the south-east of England and in France. At some of the western stations a slight rise has occurred since last evening. Pressure is least at Nain, where the reading is 0.40 in. less than at Rochefort.

Temperature has risen in Scotland, and is now very uniform about 55°; in the British Isles.

The winds are light to moderate, and have veered to W or NW on almost all coasts.

A little rain has fallen nearly everywhere, but the sky has now cleared somewhat. The sea is calm.

Fri-day

The decrease in barometrical pressure has again been general, and is greatest in the north and west, while in the south it is slight. Readings are still lowest in Scotland, and that at Naivie is 0.53 in. below that at Rochefort.

Temperature has fallen a little except in the west and France, where it has risen slightly.

The winds are in direction almost identical with those of yesterday, but have freshened somewhat in the north.

The sky is again very cloudy, and a little rain has fallen in places. The sea is calm.

REMARKS.

Satur-day

The recovery in barometrical pressure which had commenced in the north yesterday afternoon has gone on steadily to the extent of nearly 0.3 in., and has extended more or less to all our stations. Readings are now more uniform; that at Naim being only 0.30 in. below that at Rochefort.

Temperature has risen a little, except at some of the SWⁿ stations.

The winds are light to moderate. They are variable in Scotland, and generally SW^y elsewhere. In the S of France, however, a light N^y current exists.

Rain has fallen in the west and north-west. The sky is overcast, with much mist and fog at southern stations. The sea is calm.
