Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It'll be a dry, bright and breezy start for many, although in south-west England and Wales there'll be heavy rain and gales. This will affect other parts of England and Wales later this afternoon, before pushing into northern England, Northern Ireland and Scotland overnight. It'll be cold with snow possible on hills, and patchy frost elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, heavy showers will affect Scotland with some hill snow. Elsewhere there'll be varying amounts of cloud, with some wet weather possible in the far south. Sunday will be mostly dry, bright, and chilly, with scattered showers in the west.
