Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Tuesday: Dry in NE Scotland and the Northern Isles, otherwise the rest of Scotland as well as Northern/Eastern/Northeastern counties of England: further showery rain, heavy/thundery in places with local flooding. Northern Ireland/Rest of England & Wales: patchy mist/fog lifting, then sunny periods, showers, perhaps rainy in N Ireland for a time. Warm and humid, cooler in the northeast.  
Tuesday evening/night:- Far northeast Scotland, largely dry, but rest of Scotland/northeastern counties England: further rain possible, some heavy. Rest of England Wales, Northern Ireland: Clear intervals, scattered showers, patchy mist and fog.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Continuing unsettled with further periods of rain or showers, some heavy and thundery, interspersed with brighter drier interludes. Warm and humid for many.
