Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Most places will be noticeably less humid than today, although  
southeastern areas will still become warm. Otherwise in England and  
Wales, any patchy fog will soon lift to leave a mostly fine day with  
a fair amount of sunshine. Only in Cumbria is there an outside chance  
of a few light showers.

For Scotland and Northern Ireland, there will be a mixture of sunny  
intervals and showers with most of these in more western and northern  
regions, especially in northwest Scotland, where a breezy day is  
expected.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Some rain moving from the northwest, although southwest England  
should stay dry.
