Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Although all regions will have sunny periods today, it is going to feel much fresher than recently. There will be a number of showers around with most of these in western and northern areas, where some snow is expected on the higher hills. Further south and east, only a few showers are likely. Tonight, most areas will be fine and dry with slight frost in many places. However, some showers will continue towards the west and north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain or snow will reach the southwest on Sunday and other southern areas on Monday. Otherwise, showers will turn increasingly wintry during Monday.
