

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
The north, sunny intervals and heavy, blustery showers, turning wintry over hills. Further south, bright spells at times in eastern England but generally cloudy with outbreaks of rain, heaviest and most persistent across Wales. Very windy, gusts in excess of 60mph to the east of high ground, perhaps causing local disruption, easing in the north. Very mild in the south.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Unsettled. Wet and windy weather across the south early on Wednesday will clear leaving a brief brighter interlude with sunshine and showers. However, heavy rain and strong winds or gales will return to all areas overnight, showery weather following later Thursday.
