

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 30 Jan 2018

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty start followed by a dry day for central and southern parts with sunny spells. Patchy rain will reach southwest England later, slowly moving northeast. Rain across western Scotland, becoming heavier and more persistent, accompanied by gales in places. Rain over northwest Scotland moves south overnight. Brisk northwesterly winds will follow with blustery showers.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Rain will clear the southeast early on Wednesday, then a chilly and windy day with sunshine and scattered blustery showers, mainly in the north and west. Showers falling as snow over higher ground in the north. Chilly, windy with showers confined to coasts on Thursday.
