Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
England and Wales will be mostly dry and breezy with sunny spells. Heavy showers are likely in Scotland and the north of England. More prolonged rain will affect western Scotland later in the day. England, Wales and eastern Scotland will have a mostly dry and clear night but Western Scotland, Northern Ireland and northwest England will have rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be dry and bright for most, with warm sunny spells in the southeast. Cloud will affect the northwest, with showers in Northern Ireland and western Scotland. Saturday will be mostly dry, bright and warm, but with showers in the northwest.
