Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
A band of rain will move from the west during the day, reaching all parts by evening. Northern Ireland and mainland Scotland should become brighter and drier before evening. A brief drier spell is likely in the north of England and Wales later before further rain spreads from the west to all parts by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday, a wet start, then rain clearing all except southeast by evening. Sunshine and showers following, the showers squally in the northwest with gales. Monday, showers, some heavy, perhaps with hail and thunder. Gales for a time in northwest, best sunshine in east. Feeling cold.
