Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland will be mostly dry with some sunshine. Northern Ireland and northern England will start fine, but a band of heavy rain over southwest England and South Wales in the morning will spread northeastwards during the day. Sunshine and some heavy showers following the rain. Rain will continue in northern areas tonight whilst southern parts become drier with clear periods.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Further rain in the north on Saturday with some snow over Scottish mountains. Sunshine and heavy showers elsewhere. The showers will continue in the north and east on Sunday but most other parts should be dry with sunshine at times.
