

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Tuesday 12 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Scotland is expected to remain dry with spells of sunshine. Elsewhere, showery rain in parts of southern England will extend northwards to affect most of England and Wales, the rain or showers locally heavy with a risk of thunder. Strong easterly winds will affect most parts, although winds lighter in the south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Scotland is expected to remain mostly dry with spells of sunshine. Otherwise the unsettled spell continuing across the rest of Britain. There will be further rain or showers, occasionally heavy with a risk of thunder. Strong easterly winds will affect many eastern parts, where it will feel cool.
