Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Today:-Outbreaks of rain and strong winds will reach the southwest this morning, then extend north to reach parts of the Midlands and East Anglia, as the rain turns heavy and persistent. Elsewhere sunny intervals and scattered showers, a few heavy and thundery. Feeling cold in the wind and rain, elsewhere temperatures close to normal.

Overnight:-Rain, often heavy, persisting in the southwest while pushing north to reach northern England. Further north becoming largely dry, with clear spells. Cloudy conditions will reach remaining areas of England, although some heavy showers may also arrive.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Staying unsettled, showers or rain for most places.
