Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be cloudy and drizzly across western and upland parts of Scotland, as well as parts of Cumbria and N.Ireland tomorrow. Elsewhere, including more sheltered parts of Scotland, will be dry with sunny periods, and plenty of prolonged sunshine is forecast across central and eastern England. It will be another mild day with mostly light winds.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

It will be mostly dry with some sunshine. Some overnight frost and fog patches are likely and isolated fog patches could persist into both afternoons in sheltered eastern parts. Northwest Scotland will be more cloudy and damp. Daytime temperatures dropping to around normal.
