Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Patchy rain will soon clear the far southeast of England leaving much of the UK with a dry, sunny but cold start to the day. The fine weather will continue for most areas with plenty of sunshine and light winds. Wintry showers will, however, affect parts of Scotland although these will tend to ease later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

After a frosty and foggy start for many areas on Sunday, it will be generally dry before cloud, rain and strengthening winds affect western areas through the afternoon. Rain will clear the east on Monday morning with sunny spells and showers following from the west.
