Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Fine, dry and very warm with plenty of sunshine for most, once early  
mist clears, although isolated showers may develop this afternoon.  
Rather more cloudy with a few showers in the west at first. Heavy  
showers currently over East/Northeast Scotland will slowly clear.  
Mainly dry with clear periods tonight. Patchy mist and low cloud  
developing again.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Generally dry with plenty of sunshine on Saturday. Sunday will be  
cloudy and wet in the west with some heavy and thundery rain.  
Elsewhere, further sunny weather is expected but thundery showers are  
likely to develop in places. Very warm.
