




Yellow warning

Spells of heavy rain may lead to some travel disruption and flooding, with thunder possible towards eastern coasts.

What to expect

- Spray and sudden flooding will lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Where flooding or lightning strikes occur, there is a chance of delays and some cancellations to train and bus services
- Power cuts might occur and other services to some homes and businesses could be lost
- Flooding of homes and businesses could happen quickly, with damage to some buildings from floodwater or possibly lightning strikes

Further details

Spells of prolonged and often heavy rain will continue to affect parts of England today, before clearing from most areas this evening.

20-40 mm of rain will fall quite widely, with a few locations seeing 50-70 mm within around 12 hours - the wettest weather is likely to be over parts of East Anglia, the East Midlands and southeast England, as far west as Hampshire.

Some thunder and lightning is also possible, most likely over parts of East Anglia and southeast England but heavy rain is the main hazard.
