Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Sunday:-A cold and frosty start, then mainly dry and sunny. However, showers wintry on hills will affect northwestern coasts. Snow showers, some heavy with a risk of blizzards, will affect N.Scotland, these becoming mostly confined to Northern Isles during the day. Strong winds affecting NE.Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday snow showers in northeast dying away. Otherwise mainly dry with sunny spells, although some showers affecting northwestern coasts. Rain spreading into west later. Rain moving east on Tuesday, preceded by snow from Midlands northwards. Turning drier and brighter from the west for a time, further rain in west later. Rather cold in east.
