Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Scotland and Northern Ireland will be mainly dry with sunny spells  
but some eastern parts of Scotland will be rather cloudy this  
morning. England and Wales will be rather cloudy with scattered  
showers especially over the Wales and the Midlands. The south and the  
northwest brighter with some sunshine. Rather warm over parts of the  
south, chilly along the east coast.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday England and Wales will be dry with sunny spells  
developing whilst rain spreads south across Scotland and Northern  
Ireland. Showery rain affecting much of England and Wales on Sunday.  
Scotland and Northern Ireland dry with sunny spells.
