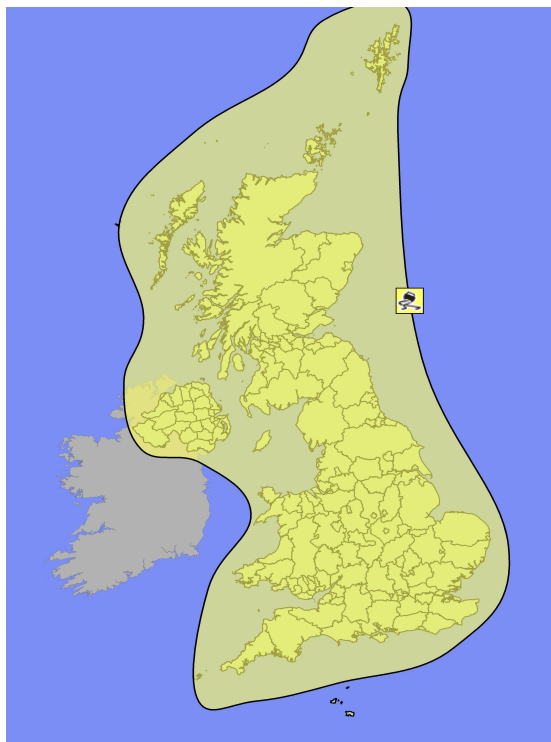




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Showers will be most frequent across northern and western parts of the UK, with some moderate accumulations of snow over high ground, whilst ice will develop on untreated surfaces left wet from showers. Surface temperatures will rise above freezing for most southern parts and low lying areas during each late morning and afternoon, but may remain below zero on higher level routes over northern parts of the UK.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Ice**

Valid from **00:05 on Sat, 17th Dec 2011** until **10:00 on Mon, 19th Dec 2011**

Wintry showers will affect parts of the UK at times over the weekend, notably the north and west, although a few parts of the east may miss the showers altogether. The public should be aware of the risk of ice on roads and pavements, particularly each night and morning.
