Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunshine and showers, heavy in places, mainly across the north with a hail and thunder risk. A dry start in the south and east, with a few light showers developing. Breezy. Tonight, mostly dry, but showers in northwest Scotland and perhaps other western coasts. Patchy rain may affect Northern Ireland later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Thursday, bright or sunny spells, especially at first in the east, but some heavy showers in the northwest. Mostly cloudy in the west with showery rain spreading in. Mostly dry and fine in the east during Friday morning, but unsettled, windy weather in the west will gradually spread east.
