Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Friday:-Scotland, Northern Ireland, sunshine and showers, these heavy and wintry at times, best sunshine in the east. Showers merging later into longer spells of rain. Other northern and central areas starting fine but showers developing, especially west. Southern parts rather cloudy with further showers at times. Feeling quite chilly, particularly in north.

Friday evening/night:-Showery rain, with sleet or snow in places, northern parts, moving southeast to clear all but southern England by morning. Wintry showers following to the northwest.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Staying unsettled, with further wintry showers, but also some bright or sunny spells. Rather cold and windy.
