Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Tuesday will be a largely cloudy and grey day for most with extensive hill fog and a few spots of drizzle. Some bright spells are likely in western parts, but rain will move into Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England during the late afternoon. Rain will move across all parts through the night.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain and hill snow will clear the north through Wednesday morning, although it may linger for a time in northeast Scotland. The rest of the day should be largely dry with sunny spells. Thursday should also be largely dry, although fog may linger in the south.
