




**Yellow warning


Further heavy rain is possible on Wednesday with a risk of flooding.

What to expect

- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Where flooding occurs, there is a slight chance of delays or cancellations to train and bus services
- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- There is a small chance that some communities become cut off by flooded roads
- There is a small chance of fast flowing or deep floodwater causing danger to life

Further details

A band of heavy rain may move north and reach this area on Wednesday, where it could then become slow moving for a time. If this occurs many locations across the northern Midlands and southern Pennines would likely see 10-20 mm of rainfall, with the potential to see as much as 40-60 mm over eastern Pennines in particular. There remains quite a lot of uncertainty regarding this event and the warning will be updated during subsequent days.
