Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mostly dry with plenty of sunny spells today. However, southern parts will have a rather cloudy start, but gradually becoming fine for most, whilst the southeast will see some showers, only slowly clearing through the day. Locally rather warm.
Generally dry tonight with clear spells and some mist patches developing.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Largely dry with sunny spells tomorrow. However, cloud and rain will push across Scotland and N.Ireland during the day. That rain will move over England and Wales before clearing on Wednesday. Some showers are likely over northwest Scotland, but otherwise it should be fine. Temperatures around or just above normal.
