Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Many areas dry, though patchy rain southwest Scotland and northwest England, with a few light showers elsewhere. There will be sunny spells, especially over northern Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland, but many parts stay cloudy. Patchy fog will be reluctant to clear. Temperatures a little below normal generally but cold where fog persists. Mostly light winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Rather cloudy on Thursday for central and southern England and Wales, with a little rain in places. Otherwise, sunny spells developing from north once fog clears. Rain at times over Scotland and Northern Ireland Friday. Dry further south but with persistent fog patches.
