Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Wednesday:-Residual overnight rain will slowly clear eastwards. A drier and brighter gap will follow from the west, which in turn will be followed by a band showers, locally heavy and perhaps thundery, the showers mainly reaching western, central and southern regions. Clearer, windy weather with showers reaching the far west later. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday:-Cloud and rain will soon arrive in the southwest, and spread northeast, covering Wales and much of England by the end of the day. Becoming windy in the southwest. Elsewhere bright, with coastal showers. Feeling cold in the rain.

Friday:-Unsettled with rain or showers. Windy in west.
