Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 05 October to 1800 UTC Monday 06 October 2014

General Situation

A developing low moving in from the Atlantic will bring very windy and wet weather from the northwest. Showery, but calmer conditions will follow from the west to all but the far northeast tomorrow.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, backing east 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough, becoming high in east.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9 in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in north.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Smooth becoming moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly, veering westerly or southwesterly, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in east.

Rain at first, then thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3, becoming southerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later, veering westerly 4 or 5 later in west.

Smooth, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 6 to gale 8 at first in east, otherwise westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South, veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9, then veering west 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in lyme bay.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 to storm 10, then veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high for a time.

Rain for a time, then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in the Bristol Channel.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10, then veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, occasionally south, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic then southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 or 7, increasing gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Rain then showers.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10, then veering west or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally southwesterly 5 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 6 to gale 8, backing southeasterly gale 8 to storm 10, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later, then becoming variable 3.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Thundery showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 or storm 10, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later, then becoming variable 3.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high for a time.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.
Showers at first.
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 or storm 10, veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 in south, southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic or easterly 6 to gale 8 in north.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in north.
Showers, then rain in north.
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 or storm 10, veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in west.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4 in south, southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic or easterly 6 to gale 8 in north.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in far north.
Showers, then rain in north.
Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 1800 UTC until Monday 06 Oct 2014 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A complex and deep depression will develop to the west of Scotland on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8 imminent, backing southeasterly and increasing severe gale force 9 later, issued at 0342

Southeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Rough, becoming very rough in southwest.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 06 Oct until 1800 UTC on Monday 06 Oct:
Southeast 6 to gale 8 increasing severe gale 9.
Rough or very rough, becoming high in east.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 to 4, increasing 5 to 6 by midnight and 7 to gale 8 by dawn, veering west to northwest around midday and decreasing 4 to 5, backing southwest 2 to 4 in the afternoon.

Slight, becoming mainly rough overnight.

Fair becoming cloudy, rain by dawn, locally heavy, clearing around midday.

Very good, becoming moderate to poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest to west 2 to 4, very soon increasing 4 to 5, locally 6 and gusty near showers.

Moderate to rather rough with a swell.

Scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.
