

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across southern England will push east through the day. Rather cloudy but drier elsewhere, although showers affecting many eastern areas, possibly wintry across the north. It will be rather chilly in a brisk wind. Rain will clear southeastern areas overnight although showers persisting across the northeast and southwestern England. Mainly dry elsewhere with a patchy frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Rather cloudy across the north on Wednesday with scattered showers but some parts will stay dry. Wet and windy weather will spread north across central and southern areas through the day. Unsettled on Thursday with rain or showers accompanied by a strong wind.
