Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A band of snow from southeast England across the Midlands into Wales and parts of Northern-Ireland will move north into northern England through the morning. Some heavy falls of snow are possible in places, especially over the hills. The snow should turn lighter and more patchy by afternoon. The southwest of England will be milder but mostly cloudy with occasional heavy showers. Scotland will have some bright spells but with wintry showers in the east.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Continuing cold over Scotland with snow at times. Gradually becoming milder elsewhere but mostly rather cloudy with showers or longer periods of rain.
