Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It'll be a much fresher day over England & Wales, with temperatures several degrees cooler than Sunday's. Most parts will see a mixture of sunshine and showers, which could be heavy in places. The north of Scotland however will be cloudy with some heavy rain at times.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Northern Scotland will hang on to the thickest cloud and some rain for much of Tuesday. The rest of the country, although perhaps more cloudy at times than Monday, should see some sunshine and a scattering of showers which could be heavy in the south. Wednesday should be fine and dry for most.
