

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 01 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, locally heavy, across central Scotland and northeast England slowly easing. Patchy fog and low cloud affecting some southern and eastern coasts throughout. Elsewhere, early fog patches clearing, with warm sunny spells developing. Isolated heavy showers possible in south and northeast later, these easing in east overnight, but spreading slowly northwards in the west. Elsewhere dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Occasionally heavy showers in the west easing during Wednesday. Cloudy, dull across some eastern parts. Elsewhere dry with some warm sunshine. Becoming very warm in the southeast. Thursday, a band of locally heavy showery rain across western parts slowly progressing northeastwards.
