Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across Scotland will gradually ease with southern and central parts becoming largely dry and bright. Sunny spells and scattered showers are expected elsewhere, although some southern areas will remain dry. Overnight, showers will continue in northern Scotland and some parts of England but most places will be dry with clear periods. It will become rather windy and feel cool.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be largely dry with sunny periods in many places, with scattered showers largely confined to northern Scotland and the Midlands. On Wednesday rain will spread across northern parts, becoming heavy in places. Southern areas should remain largely dry.
