

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain may linger across southeast England until midday but most other parts of the UK will be largely dry with pleasant sunny spells. Scattered sharp showers are expected around southern and western coastal areas though. Overnight it will be mostly dry and chilly, with fog across eastern parts of the country but rain will spread to westernmost areas by morning.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Outbreaks of rain will continue slowly eastwards across many parts on Wednesday but eastern England and eastern Scotland should remain dry, bright and very mild. Rain will gradually clear during Thursday leaving scattered showers. Winds will be strong and southeasterly.
