General Situation

Low pressure across the United Kingdom will continue the run of unsettled weather.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 until later northeast of Orkney, otherwise variable 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic then easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5,
occasionally 6 later in southeast.

Moderate at first in far north, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in east.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 at first in far north, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Moderate at first near Rattray Head, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or northeasterly 5 or 6 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight becoming smooth.

Occasional rain until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwesterly 5 later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain until later.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, veering northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Mainly moderate in far west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers until later.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, veering northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers until later.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near St Davids Head.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming west or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Smooth, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming variable, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, becoming west or northwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly 4 or 5 for a time in east, occasionally westerly 5 later in southeast.

Smooth or slight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly west or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally variable 3 at first.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly 4 or 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Variable 3 or less, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Mainly south 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Moderate until later in far south, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later Ardnamurchan Point.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Mainly south 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low west of Shetland extends troughs towards Shetland on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Moderate.

Fog patches mainly in west. Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 03 Jun until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 04 Jun:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in southwest.

Moderate.

Fog patches mainly in west. Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 2 to 4, veering northwest around dawn tomorrow and increasing 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.

Isolated showers, rain spreading in from the southwest late afternoon.

Moderate to good, locally poor especially in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 4 by midnight, backing southwest 2 to 4 by dawn.

Moderate to rather rough, decreasing overnight.

Any rain soon clearing to isolated showers.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
