Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain affecting southern parts through the day, heavy in places at first, but becoming lighter as it eases north. Largely dry in the north with sunny spells, although rain pushing into northern Scotland later. Overnight, becoming cloudy across the UK with patchy rain for many. Turning colder across Scotland with wintry showers and strengthening winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Largely cloudy on Friday with rain at times and wintry showers affecting parts of Scotland. Winds strengthening across northern areas. Largely dry and bright on Saturday although rain affecting some southern parts, with further wintry showers across parts of Scotland. Rather cold with overnight frost.
